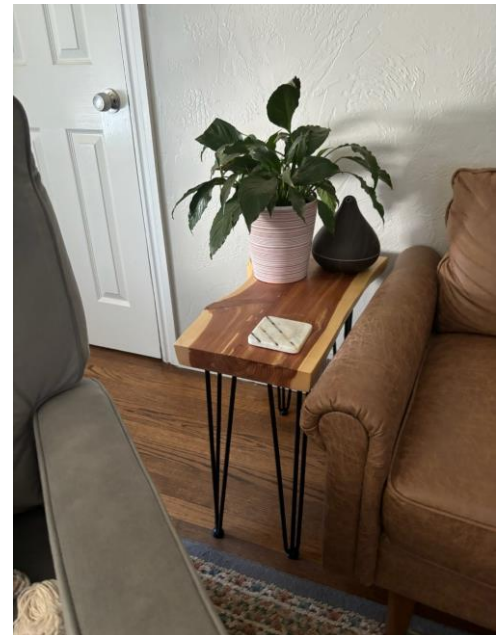


A customer from Moore, Oklahoma envisioned a modern/rustic powder room vanity top crafted out of live edge pecan. This look brought natural beauty into this functional space.
