Our best seller in this category is our glow-in-the-dark snowflakes! We are constantly amazed how many of these we sell! They look great with every décor and can be displayed from September through February!



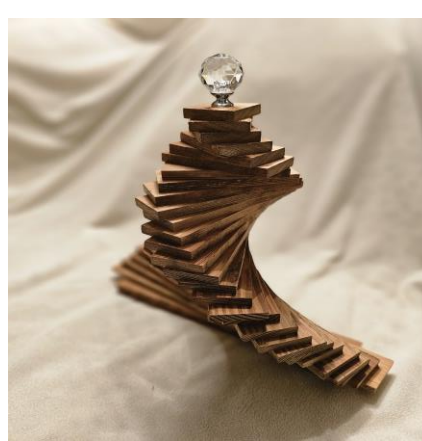
Not only are our lath storage boxes attractive; they are very functional! We have made many different sizes and use them in our displays at shows!
