

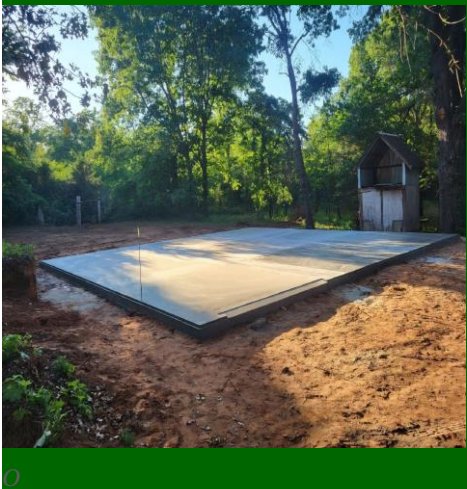

Slab is curing and waiting for the building!



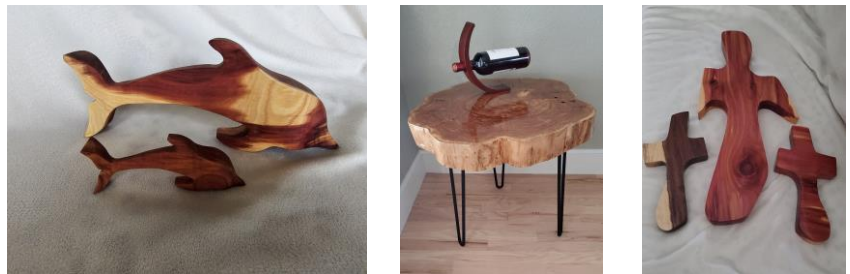
WHAT'S MY STYLE???

You're out shopping for furniture, maybe a coffee or dining table, and you wonder would that look good in your house? Here are a few styles and complimentary wood décor to make your home unique!

Bohemian or "BOHO" style is eclectic and incorporates natural materials with pops of vibrant colors; creating a warm space that celebrates creativity. Decorative pieces incorporate woven materials or macrame.



Eclectic style embraces a diverse mix of pieces to create a personalized look with handcrafted items; mixing a rustic live edge table with mid-century modern metal legs. This is a fearless approach to design.



Mid-century modern style incorporates clean lines and minimalist forms while highlighting the beauty of natural wood. This form became popular in the 1940s to 1960s. Popular mid-century modern woods are walnut, oak and rosewood. Use of earth tones, such as creams and browns, mixed with metal and glass are common in this style.



Rustic furniture employs sticks, twig, logs and reclaimed wood for a natural, “outdoorsy” look. The rustic style has been around for over 150 years but made a big resurgence during the 1980’s with the newer “farmhouse” look. This style embodies raw natural appearance and handcrafted charm.



Traditional style encompasses elegant and timeless creations using rich woods such as cherry, oak, walnut and maple. The furniture showcases meticulous craftsmanship and attention to detail. This style creates an heirloom-quality piece. Transitional style is very similar to traditional but adds comfortable, lived in furniture and lighter wood tones.
